QUALIFICATION	Men: 87 players Ladies: 33 players If the number of registrations exceeds the limits stated above, the players with the highest HCPI will not qualify for the competition. They will be informed by their home club.

TEEING AREA	Back tees Men: 62 (white) Ladies: 55 (blue)
CUT	There will be a cut after the 1 st round: The best 39 men + ties and the best 15 ladies + ties will continue play on Sunday.
